Dear parents and carers,

As we approach the autumn/winter season, we want to ensure that you are aware about the risk of winter bugs like flu and norovirus, and the opportunity to protect your child's health with the flu vaccine. Please see a letter attached from Lambeth regarding information on flu vaccinations.

We have also attached a letter from last year regarding awareness of scarlet fever. Please remain vigilant and look out for symptoms in your child, because early treatment of scarlet fever with antibiotics is important to reduce the risk of complications. Remember to contact NHS 111 or your GP if you suspect your child has scarlet fever and if they are unwell, keep them at home until at least 24 hours after the start of antibiotic treatment to avoid spreading the infection to others.
